The purpose is to raise community awareness about sexual assault and abuse and the free services that Foothills Alliance offers to survivors and their friends and family. It also will raise funds to support prevention education programs in Anderson and Oconee Counties.

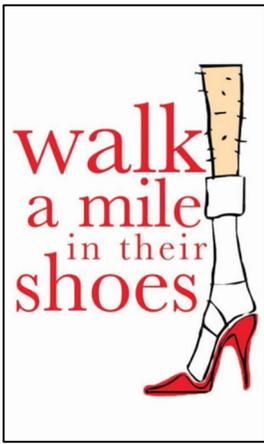
Foothills Alliance, founded in 1989 as the Foothills Rape Crisis Center, has been serving adult and child victims of sexual abuse for 28 years. We are the only sexual assault center for Anderson and Oconee Counties. "Working in collaboration with community partners, the mission of Foothills Alliance is to prevent sexual assault trauma and child abuse and neglect by providing education, advocacy, and treatment services in Anderson and Oconee counties." The organization successfully runs multiple programs, including: parent support groups, child abuse prevention and parent education, community and school education and awareness programs, a 24 hour-7-days-a-week crisis hotline, emergency room advocacy for victims, an active and vital volunteer program, treatment and advocacy for sexually abused children, professional training for local agency personnel, and a full range of clinical services provided by masters'-level licensed counselors.
